Dear Applicant,

Welcome to the application procedure of DAFM!

Here you will find all the necessary information for the submission of your application.

Please read carefully before submitting your application.

1. Danube Agrifood master program

You are applying for the Danube Agrifood Master. The DAFM is an Erasmus Mundus Joint Master, and excellence programme of the European Union.

2. General information

- The online application procedure takes some time, so take that into consideration.
- Before starting your application, make sure you have all the required documents you will have to attach to your application.
- All documents must be in pdf-format. Documents in other formats will not be considered.
- All documents must be in English language. If it is not the case, add an English translation done by a certified, court-approved translator officially recognized by the issuing country.

If you are selected to DAFM you must provide legalized documents such as your diploma, transcript of records or birth certificate. Those documents are not required at application stage so you don't need to initiate expenditures in case of a nonselection of your application.

For graduates of bachelor's programs which are not listed above, mastery of agricultural sciences is required.

Your eligibility will be evaluated based on your transcripts.

If your average GPA is less than the 75% of the maximum GPA in your institution/country, your application will not be considered.

- Don't wait until the last moment to submit your application, as the platform might shut down, if too many applications are submitted at the same time.
- You can't submit more than one application. In this case, both application will be rejected.
- Please make sure to fill in ALL your data in accordance with your original documents (name(s), passport details, details of your diploma etc.).
- If your filled in data and the data in your documents do not match, or data is missing or wrong, your application will be rejected automatically.
- **Be aware, that your application will be rejected without any possibility of appeal, if your application is not complete, is not filled in correctly, your filled in data don't match with the original documents or if you have uploaded wrong documents!**

Passport: Number --> very importantly, in case of selection, you will have to provide a passport, that is valid for at least 2 and a half years.

Task: Proof of English language proficiency --> Certificate of official international English language exam. We also accept your university's attesting English is the medium of instruction of your higher education, **HOWEVER** due to the high interest shown in our programme, we warmly recommend every applicant to provide an official international language test.

(PLEASE NOTE! Applicants who select BOKU/Vienna for the 2nd year, have to provide the proof of English proficiency required by BOKU at the time of application!)

Task: Privacy Statement DAFM --> This document is to be found in the DreamApply system, and needs to be read and signed.

Task: Europass CV --> must be in Europass format

Task: Proof of place of residence --> Any kind of card stating your current residence issued by an authority

Task: Declaration of honour --> This document is to be found in the DreamApply system, and needs to be read and signed.

Untitled task --> Other documents you consider relevant for the application (such as an affidavit, in case your name has changed in your documents, medical proof of special needs, DOI-number of publications, link of abstract books of the participation in conferences that you mention in your CV).



PLEASE, prioritize. Only submit the 3 most important publications/abstract of books of your choice. More documents of this category, or publications and participations without official proof, won't be considered.
